In our 2021 Open Source Database Trend Report, we look at the top open source database technologies, from database management systems and NoSQL databases to data engine technologies.


The report presents the results of two surveys focused on these technologies. The first, a survey of 200 development professionals, and the second, a survey of our team of Enterprise Architects.

For part one of this report, we conducted a public survey of development professionals. The survey, which ran between May and June 2021, received a total of 211 responses.


The survey was centered on database technologies, with respondents asked to share their knowledge, experiences, and plans for working with top open source options.
